




Palomar Medical Center – Escondido Hospital Information

- Parking is FREE
- Temporary "drop off" parking in front of main hospital entrance is allowed
- Complimentary valet available for laboring mothers*
- Wheelchairs available at main entrance if needed
- Enter main lobby, check in at desk in the lobby, then onto 8th floor
 - Not recommended to enter through emergency department

Labor & Delivery | General Guidelines

When to call 442-281-1285 (24 hour call back)

- If your water breaks
- If you are not feeling baby move
- If you become injured, have vaginal bleeding, or abdominal pain
- If you begin experiencing contractions
 - First baby: 3 to 5 minutes apart lasting 60 seconds and consistent for 1 hour
 - Second or more: 5 to 7 minutes apart lasting 45-60 seconds and consistent for 1 hour

Always follow the advice of your provider

Visitation Policy

- Two visitors over the age of 16 PLUS a certified doula are allowed.
- Visitors may not accompany patient if sick with a cough or fever
- All visitors are encouraged to be up to date with all vaccinations

Post Partum Unit

General Information

- Located on the 8th floor
- 24 private rooms
- Private bathroom with shower
- Sleeping accommodations provided for primary support
- Well newborns will "room in"
- Newborn procedures done at bedside
- Pediatrician will examine baby before discharge

Post Partum Unit

Length of Stay

- 1-2 days after vaginal birth
- 3-4 days after cesarean birth
- Length of stay dependent on delivery and the condition of mom & baby.



Visitation Policy

- Only 1 primary support person permitted throughout stay
- Laboring support person may not switch out with another visitor
- Primary Support person may not leave the hospital at any time before discharge
