Hospital Information

9455 Clairemont Mesa Blvd. San Diego, CA 92123

Parking Structure is located off Clairemont Mesa Blvd.

- Structure entrance located on Thrive
 Driveway across from Main Hospital Entrance
- Labor & Delivery parking spaces located on lower level
- Temporary *Drop Off* parking in the front of the main hospital entrance is allowed
- Wheelchairs available at main entrance
- Enter through main hospital entrance and proceed to 3rd floor*



Parking is FREE

^{*} Not recommended to enter through Emergency Department

Labor & Delivery | General Guidelines

When to call (858) 266-3350

- If your water breaks
- If you are not feeling baby move
- If you become injured, have vaginal bleeding, or abdominal pain
- If you begin experiencing contractions
 - First baby: 3 to 5 minutes apart lasting 60 seconds and consistent for 2 hours
 - Second or more: 5 to 7 minutes apart lasting 45-60 seconds and consistent for 1 hour

Always follow the advice of your provider

Visitation Policy

- Four visitors total allowed
- Visitors may not accompany patient if sick with a cough or fever
- All visitors are encouraged to be up to date with all vaccinations
- Children under 12 are limited to siblings and must be accompanied by an adult whose only task is their care

Labor & Delivery Unit

General Information

- Located on the 3rd floor
- Check-in 3rd floor admitting desk
- 12 private labor suites with private on-suite bathrooms and showers
- 6 Triage rooms
- 3 Operating Room Suites
- 2-4 Physicians & 2 Midwives on staff
- Sleeping accommodation provided for primary support person only
- Skin to skin encouraged after delivery
- Infant weight and measurement delayed for golden hour
- Recovery period 1-2hrs after delivery then transfer to Post Partum



Post Partum Unit

General Information

- Located on the 3rd floor
- 48 private rooms
- Private bathroom with shower
- Sleeping accommodations provided for primary support
- Well newborns will "room in"
- Newborn procedures done at bedside
- Pediatrician will examine baby before discharge

Post Partum Unit

Length of Stay

- 1-2 days after vaginal birth
- 2-4 days after cesarean birth
- Length of stay dependent on delivery and the condition of mom & baby.

- All visitors are encouraged to be up to date with all vaccinations
- Children under 12 are limited to siblings and must be accompanied by an adult whose only task is their care
